Maths

We have almost finished our learning about place value. We have looked at counting in fifties and related it to counting in fives. We have tried to estimate where numbers from 1-1000 will fall on a number line and we have revised how to say and write numbers to 1000.

Science

This week we have learnt the names of the different parts of a flowering plant and we have looked at the job each part does. We have also observed the changes in our thyme plants since last week. We measured any growth and noted any changes in colour and strength.

Geography

In geography this week, we have learnt about the economy on the Costa Blanca.
