Some of us enjoyed doing puzzles and played some games of Old McDonald lotto. We had fun with other cutting and art activities too.

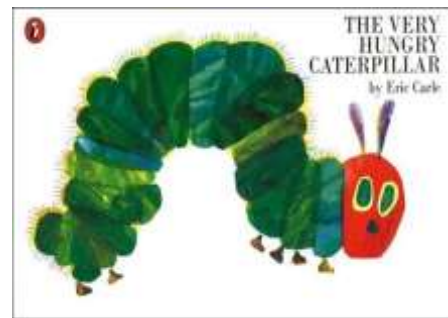
