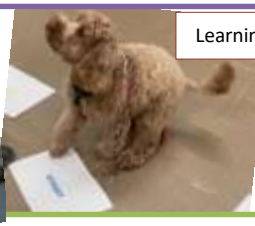


Dear Children,

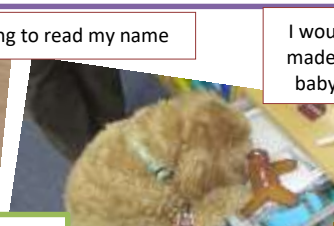

Amber RULES!

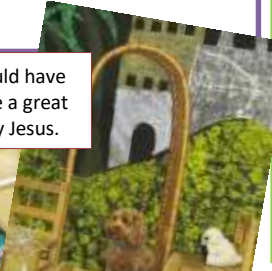
Approach me calmly from the front
