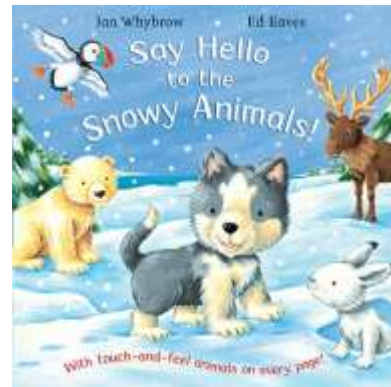


In phonics this week, we are learning the phoneme 'd'.
