Reading:

Next week the children will be coming home with their reading diary, a Little Wandle book and a library book to share with an adult. Please encourage your child to read their Little Wandle book 5 times a week and record it in their yellow reading diary. They should be reading it completely fluently with expression by the end of the week and able to answer lots of questions about the text. We will swap their reading diaries every Friday but please make sure they have their reading books and diaries in school every day as an adult in school will read with them 3 times a week. The library book is for an adult to read and share with them at home and discuss it. We do ask for parents to replace the books if a child loses or damages them so please do look after them.

In their reading diary you will find their Numbot password with a letter explaining how to download it. This is a great math's resource which helps to improve their counting and fluency. Please explore this with your child at home.
