We have had a focus on the classes of words especially the use of adverbs and adverbials. We also inferred characteristics of a character based upon an image. We have identified problems in the 'King Kong' story and how they were resolved by the characters and then inferred how the characters felt at the time.

In Art we created our special Christmas cards. This involved using some watercolour painting techniques.



We explored the force of air-resistance. In discussion we designed a fair test. We made parachutes, made predictions and timed their descent using Ipad. We tabulated the results and thought about what we had learned about air-resistance.
