Autumn Term

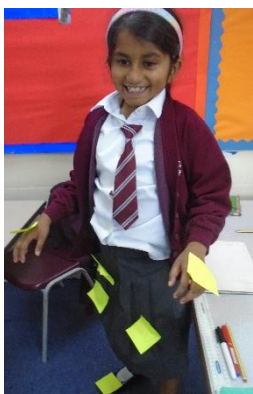
PE-Gymnastics
