

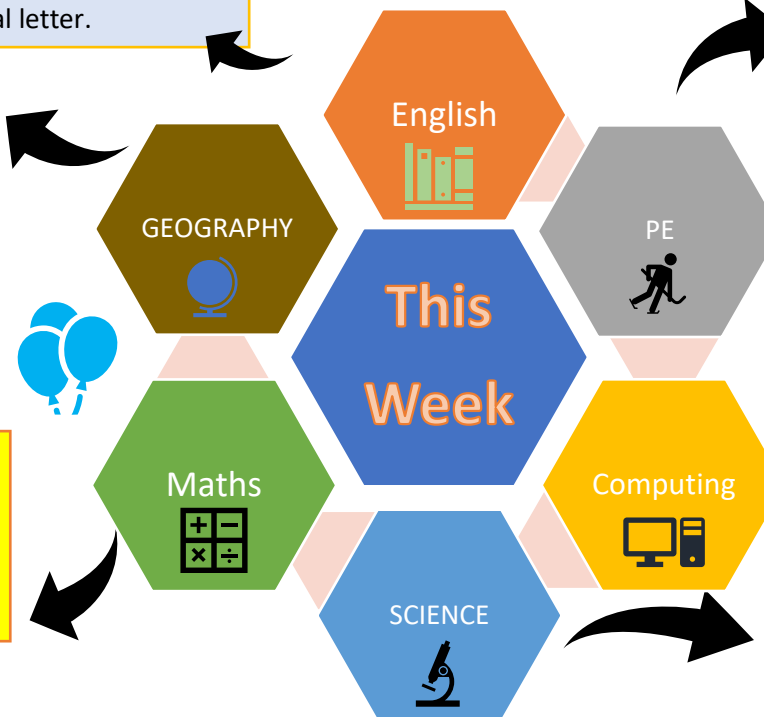
YEAR 5 LEARNING LETTER 8/12/23

We have started our new book, 'The lost Thing'. We made predictions about the content and theme of the book. We used different types of expanded noun phrases to describe our own 'lost thing' and wrote a tag. We wrote a diary entry for the boy in the book focusing on using subordinating conjunctions to start a sentence. We also tried to use the subjunctive mood when writing a formal letter.



We had a pause last week because of the weather but this week we resumed learning about dribbling, passing and retrieving, beating defenders and playing in a Hockey team.

We were map reading this week. We used 4 figure grid references using a simple sketch map. We then tried to use 6 figure grid references on O.S maps that showed parts of the journey of the River Thames.



Having learned about different camera angles and techniques, this week we used a storyboard to plan our own short video.



We have been practising adding fractions and mixed numbers. We have been making denominators the same, simplifying fractions and converting improper fractions to mixed numbers.

We investigated irreversible changes. Acting like real scientists we mixed different materials. Some reacted and produced a new material.
