English

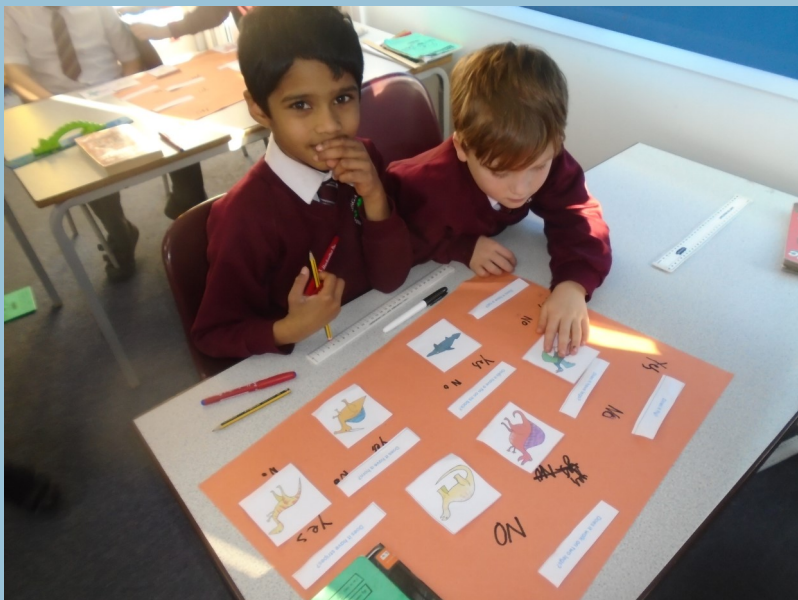
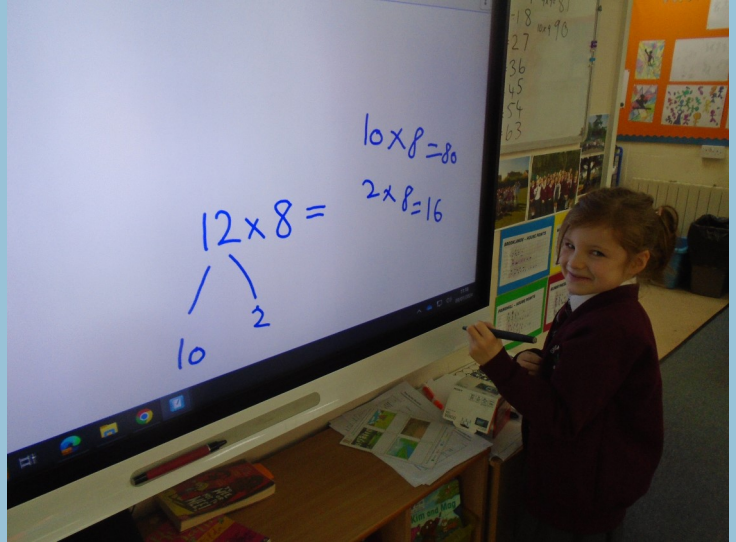
This week we have been reading *Stone Age Boy* by Satoshi Kitamura. We have used the story to explore word classes and using descriptive language, as well as to learn how to punctuate direct speech. We have begun to plan our own story based on this book, using our prior knowledge of the Stone Age.

Maths

In maths, we have learned a to multiply a two digit number by a one digit number using partitioning. We have also looked at the relationship between multiplication and division. We welcomed new tiny teachers, Miss Penelope and Mr Judd who helped to explain partitioning to the children.
