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## This week in Beech Class...

### English

We have spent a lot of time this week working on our presentation. We have discussed how writing is about communication and the importance of people being able to read our handwriting. We then spent three sessions writing our Stone Age Boy stories. The children showed a lot of perseverance and concentration.

### Maths

We have continued to look at multiplication and division, this time exchanging tens for ones and we have looked at dividing with remainders. The children will find this work much easier with a good recall of their times tables. In class we have been doing TT Rockstars, but children should also be learning their 3s, 4s, and 8s at home.

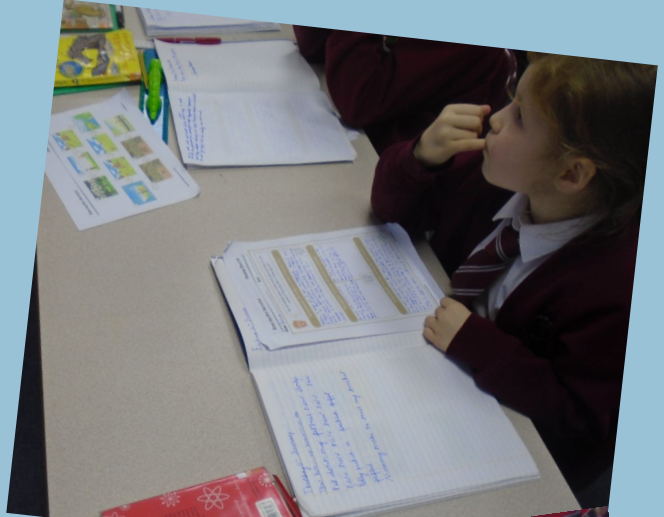
### PE
