We have started to think about and design our own imaginary settings that we will use in our story writing next week.

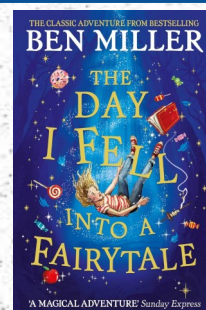
Parents evening booking
