This week in English, we have written a newspaper article about the big Pok-a-tok game featured in our Mayan text, Rainplayer. As part of digital week, children have used computers to write the front page of a newspaper.

In maths, we have been using concrete resources to help consolidate our understanding of multiplication and moved on to division - dividing 2-digit numbers by a 1-digit number.

We continued to experiment with building circuits in science this week, investigating which materials are good conductors and which are insulators.

In history, we have analysed photos and videos of archaeological sites of ancient Mayan ruins, using reasoning to consider the purpose of some of these buildings.

As part of our PSHE unit on identifying and managing feelings, we talked about grief this week and how loss, in all its forms, can affect feelings and behaviours. I am always so proud of how well the children engage in these lessons, listening and sharing, with respect for each other.
