

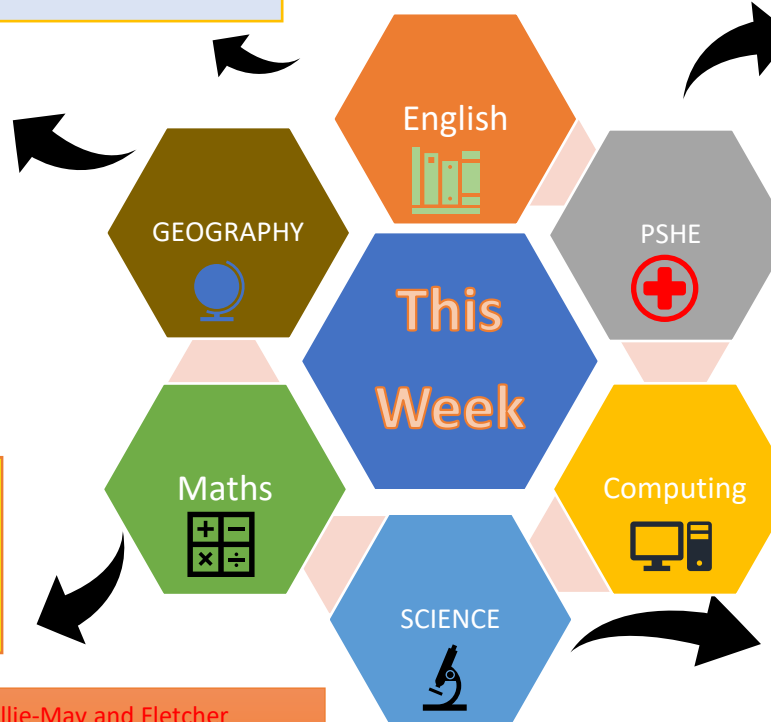
YEAR 5 LEARNING LETTER 26/1/24

We have finished learning about parenthesis- using brackets, dashes and commas. We wrote some poetry using figurative language – similes and metaphors. We had great fun trying to understand and translate the language of Shakespeare.



This week we added to our 'First Aid Powerpoint' by giving guidance on how to help people who have suffered a burn

We compared the Cambrian mountains, in Wales, with the Himalaya. We drew a relief map of the UK, identifying where the highest areas are, and then compared the heights to the Himalaya. We suggested reasons for the differences



We used a program called Flowol to create flowcharts for algorithms. We used 'mimics' on the screen to judge our success.

We finished our topic on multiplication and division and have returned to fractions. This time we have been multiplying fractions.
