ASSESSMENT WEEK

This week we have been completing assessments in writing, reading and maths to measure the children's progress ahead of half term. The children were assessed in arithmetic, reasoning and problem-solving, working completely independently and showing their knowledge of different methods to work out the answers.

Reading was assessed by way of a STAR test on Accelerated Reader. This gives us valuable data, not only on the child's ability but on their strengths and weaknesses and areas to work on.

For writing, the children were given a picture as a writing stimulus and a little time to plan a story, then they set to work.

FRENCH
