Responsible to: the Headteacher

Purpose:

To provide excellent teaching and enjoyable learning for the children.

To assist in the development of the curriculum throughout the school.

Responsibilities:

- To uphold the teaching standards as set out by the DfE
- To meet, share ideas and plan co-operatively with members of the key stage and ensure enjoyment, continuity and progression in learning.
- To implement and maintain the school's pastoral care and discipline policy, taking into account the personal, social and emotional needs of the child.
- To assess own areas of need regarding professional development and seek out opportunities to address these through CPD.

Teaching and Learning:

- To demonstrate good practice in terms of classroom teaching and organisation.
- To assess pupils in a manner agreed record and report this as necessary.
- To implement plans in an inclusive, motivating and supportive way using a range of teaching strategies, taking into account the needs of individual pupils.

Strategic Development:

- To contribute to discussion of the school's aims and policies and participate in the implementation of policies, plans, targets and practices.
- To assist in developing policy and the school development plan.

Leadership:

- To plan and manage the work of teaching assistants.
- To lead the work of colleagues as appropriate in order to promote effective teaching and learning for pupils.
