Highlights of the Week

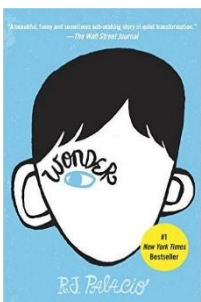
In our science lessons we are learning about evolution and inheritance. The children have been thinking about adaptation and how different living things are adapted to live in certain environments and habitats.

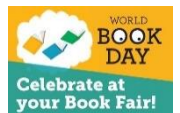
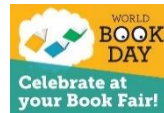
World Book Day
