This week, our time learning has included learning to tell the time to a quarter hour, to five minutes and to the minute. Any support from home would also be appreciated.

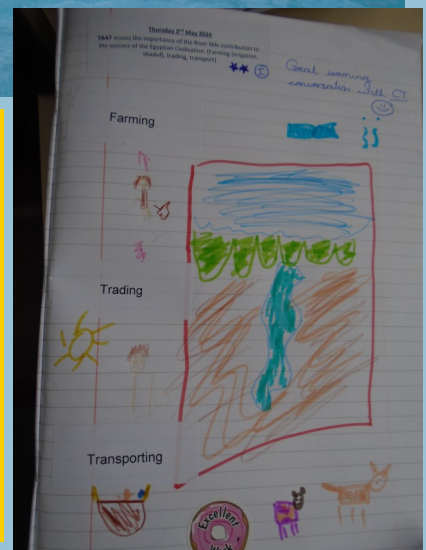
