Welcome to Year 6!

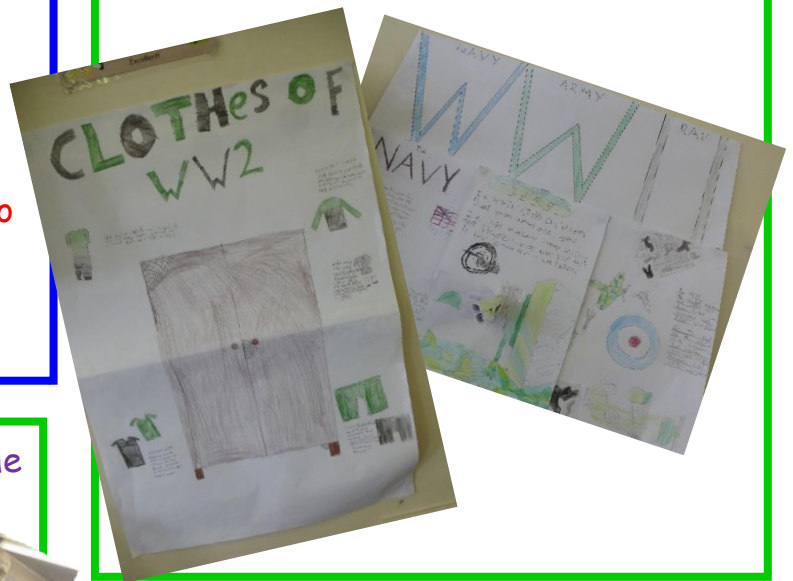

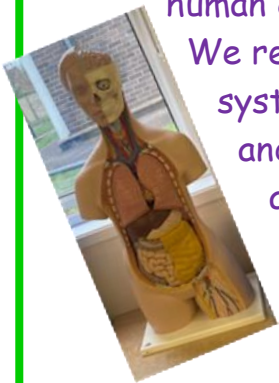
