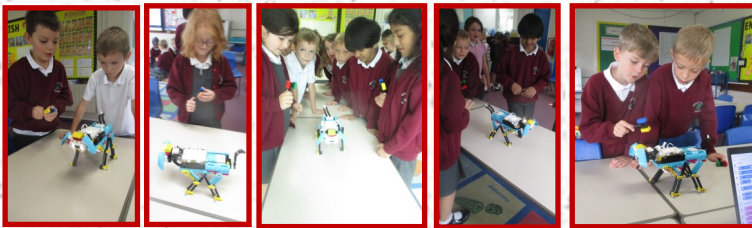

Greetings on the Gate

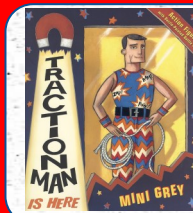
Every morning Mrs Masey and I stand on the gate to welcome the children in. It is one of my favourite parts of the day.
