## Autumn Term

### Art

During our art session this week, the children understood how texture can be created and used to make art. The children used a variety of colours to make four different textures per sheet. Next, the children worked with their rubbings to create shapes to form their final picture.



### Maths

This week, the children continued their Maths journey with learning about Place Value. The children continued to order numbers up to 1,000 from smallest to greatest, and from greatest to smallest. For consistency, we used the word "greatest" rather than "biggest" or "largest" when describing numbers. The children were also introduced to the language "ascending" and "descending". The children learnt to compare numbers using concrete resources, pictorial representations, words and symbols.
