

YEAR 5 LEARNING LETTER 4/10/24



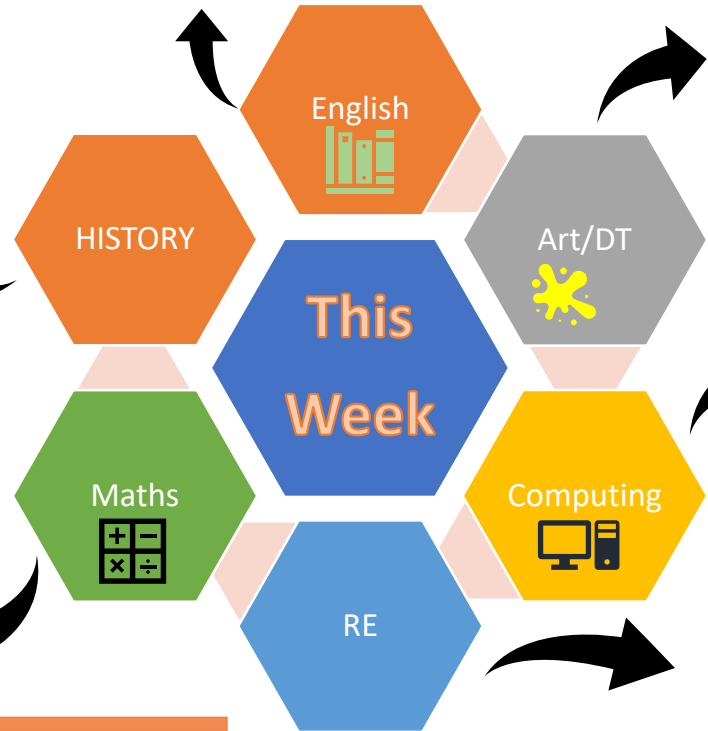
In SPAG we have looked at the tricky problem of apostrophes for possession with plurals. We have finished the KING KONG story. We have inferred the emotions of characters at different parts of the story and written a diary account. We have storyboarded the main events of the story and begun to think about writing a newspaper report about the events in the story.

We created a background for our portraits this week. We used collage to create a colourful background on which to add our 'word portrait'.

We investigated the tablets found at Vindolanda. We discovered how they survived for so long and why they are so important as sources of evidence.

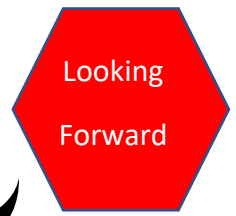


In an unplugged activity we created a webpage. We then learned about how search engines rank the results that appear in our searches. How high would our webpages appear in the rankings?
