

YEAR 5 LEARNING LETTER 18/10/24

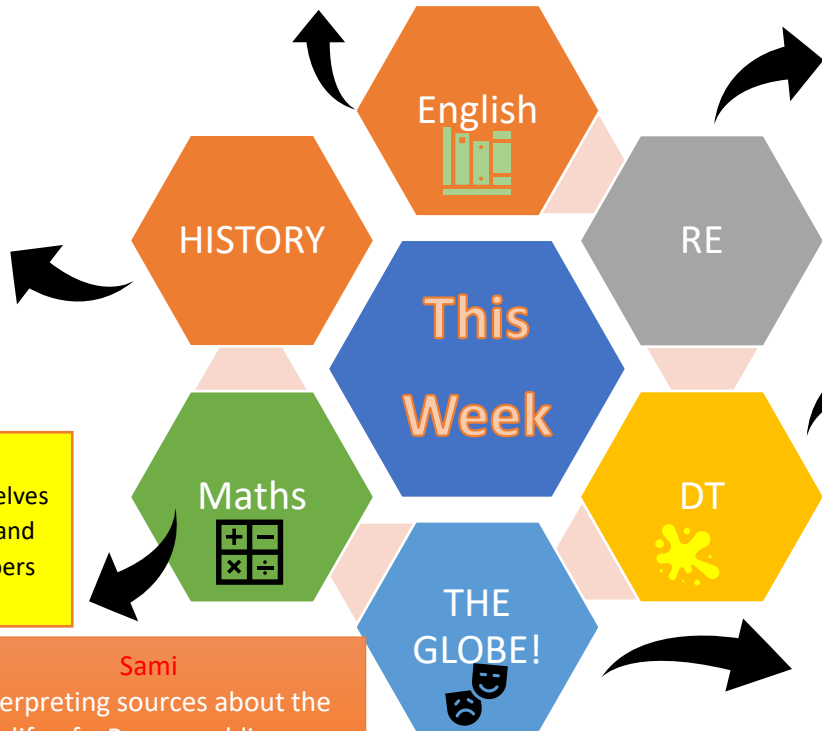
