We continue to tackle times tables in maths and this week we have looked at the relationship between 3,6 and 9 and how this can help us problem solve. We've also looked at strategies to help with tricky times tables (eg the hand/finger trick for x9 and partitioning 7 into 5 & 2 for x7)

In English, we identified the qualities of our main character 'Odd' and looked at how adding the suffix 'ous' to words can change a noun to an adjective, implementing these in our writing.

We continued to learn more about the Vikings in history and how important seafaring was to their way of life. This week, we discovered how their longships were built and why they were designed in such a way.

In science, children learnt that sounds are made when objects vibrate and these vibrations cause air particles to also vibrate, moving in sound waves until these reach our ears.

Managing conflict was the focus in our PSHE lesson this week, appreciating that conflicts can and will happen to us all. We considered how conflicts can be avoided and what tools we can use to help us when they do arise.

Fridays are forest school days, which all the children really enjoy. Mrs Bennet commented on what a lovely day she spent with Y4 last week.
