In maths this week, children have continued to work through our times tables up to 12. We were introduced to the terminology 'factors' and 'product' and recognised that when there is factor is zero in any multiplication, the answer will always be zero.

In English, we have been using adverbs and adverbial phrases to help give more detail to our verbs and extending our sentences to become more engaging for our reader.
