Our Learning Journey

Due to illness, we have not introduced any new graphemes this week. Instead, we have revisited all the sounds already learned and we have practised our tricky words.

In handwriting, we have been practising capital letters as often as possible. We have been looking at singular and plurals and the rule associated with it. Simply add "s" to the noun for instance one cat, two cats. One dog, two dogs. But if the word ends in S, X, CH, SS, SH then add "es". One kiss, many kisses. One wish, three wishes. One fox, two foxes.

In maths, we have been practising our adding and subtraction skills. We have been talking about tens and ones. We have been making groups of ten and practising our number bonds to 10 and 20 - *practise makes perfect*. As part of our cross curricular activities, we continue to include short, decodable maths problems in phonics.

Our PE session was moved due to the Maths Mastery workshop on Thursday afternoon which was a huge success. Special thank you to Ben and Evie for their help explaining our maths learning to parents.
