In maths this week, children were learning how to multiply 3 numbers and have also been building on their understanding around factors - learning about factor pairs and investigating how many factors a product has.

In English, we have been learning how to use relative pronouns to introduce relative clauses in our sentences. We have now finished reading *Odd and the Frost Giants*, which the children really enjoyed. We worked in groups to identify the key parts of the story to help us plan, ahead of our recount next week.

In science, we have been learning about 'pitch' and how high and low pitches are made. We made our own set of pan flutes, using art straws, to explore this further.

In computing, work has started on our podcast productions! This week, children recorded their spoken part, ensuring they edited to eliminate any sounds they don't want in their final recording.

In RE, we are continuing to learn about the Sikhi religion. This week we learnt about the five K's and what these symbolise to Sikhs.

Our focus in tag rugby this week, was using dodging and passing to score a try. Children are learning what movements to use to try and go past a defender and how to use their team-mates to support them if needed.
