Autumn Term

Maths

This week, the children expanded their skills in multiplication and division by focusing on the 4-times table. They applied their knowledge of multiplying and dividing by 4 to build a deeper understanding of these concepts. Using arrays, they explored partitioning in a visual and hands-on way, which reinforced their comprehension. Additionally, the children continued to investigate the commutative property of multiplication, solidifying their ability to recognize and apply patterns in mathematical operations.

Science

The children continued their exploration of forces and magnets this week, focusing on the concept of friction. Working in pairs, they designed and conducted their own investigations to measure the amount of friction created by different surfaces. Before beginning their experiments, the children made thoughtful predictions about which surface would generate the most friction.
