In maths this week, children were learning how to multiply numbers by 10 and by 100, and what this looks like on a place value chart - understanding that each time we move a place value column to the left, we are multiplying a number by 10.

In English, we have been writing our recounts, in 1st person as Odd. Children have been using subordinating conjunctions and adverbials to create more complex sentences in their writing.

In science, we explored how we create volume from different musical instruments. We learnt that loudness is the amount of energy in a sound. The energy creates different sized vibrations. The bigger vibrations cause louder sounds.

In computing, we have been putting the finishing touches to our podcasts - adding jungles and sound effects to our voice recordings and editing to create a final piece.

The hallways are filled with the sound of Christmas cheer at the moment, as children learn the songs ahead of our annual Christmas carol concert, during music lessons.

Children were introduced to King Alfred this week in history, understanding the part he played in ensuring peace between the Anglo-Saxons and Vikings, through the division of Kingdoms and the introduction of Danelaw.
