Our first learning letter of the year and we can safely say it's been a busy week here in Y4!

Our multiplication and division unit continues in maths and children have been learning to multiply and divide a 2-digit number by a 1-digit number. They have also learnt the formal written method of multiplication.

In English, we are reading a beautifully illustrated book called FaRther and using this to inspire our writing. This week, children have been writing multi-clause sentences as well as developing noun phrases to create setting descriptions.

In science, we have been exploring making circuits as part of our learning around electricity.

Ratio and proportion was our focus in art this week as children drew a still life composition. We used charcoal and rubbers to create light and dark tone within the drawing.
