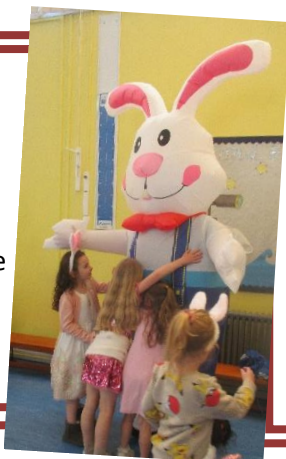


## Dear Parents,
