## Focus Learning

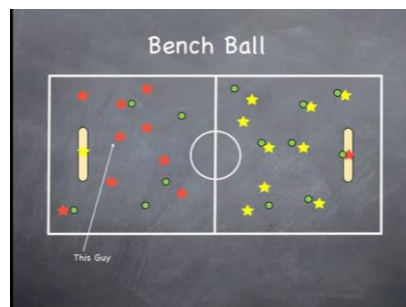
Welcome back! We hope all families have had a relaxing half term and all the children are prepared to learn.
