## Science next week



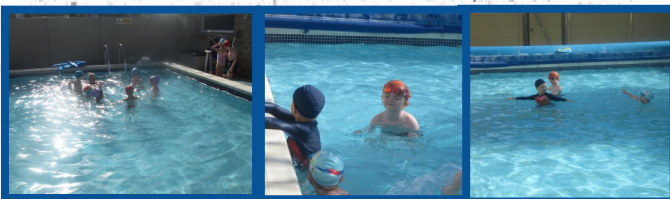
