Computing

The children began learning about the computer system by exploring the basic concepts of input, process, and output. They discovered that these three stages are the foundation of how all digital devices work. First, they were introduced to simple examples, such as pressing keys on a keyboard (input), the computer thinking or processing the information, and then displaying letters on the screen (output). As their understanding grew, the children applied this knowledge to everyday devices they recognized, like using a camera, playing on a games console, or speaking into a microphone. This helped them see how input, process, and output happen all around them in technology they use every day.

Writing

The children began their journey with the book *Leon and the Place Between*, which transported them into a world of magic and wonder. As they read, they were encouraged to explore their imaginations, picturing the magical places and events within the story. Together, they mapped out the key parts of the tale, and using their descriptive skills, they retold the story in their own words, bringing the magical world to life through their ideas and creativity.
