

YEAR 3 WEEKLY LEARNING

Autumn Term

Art

This half term, the children are focusing on sketching. They are beginning to think about the different techniques they might use and are developing an understanding that sketching is a quick, rough way of drawing using light pencil pressure. The children are learning that sketching is not about perfect detail, but about exploring ideas and building up drawings using simple shapes, with details added later when refining their work. As part of this, they have also started to explore shading and the use of even tones to bring depth and dimension to their sketches.

Drama Workshop



The children took part in an exciting drama workshop where they used their imagination and acting skills to bring the story of King Arthur and Excalibur to life. They worked together to act out different scenarios, from Arthur discovering the magical sword to knights showing their bravery and loyalty. Each child had the chance to step into a role, using expression, movement, and teamwork to retell the legendary tale in a creative and engaging way.
