The children were very excited by our little visitor to class this week - a stag beetle larvae (see photo). It was discovered by Mrs Bennett during forest school and she kindly brought him round the class so the children could see one in real life.

In maths this week, we have been comparing and ordering numbers to 10,000, rounding numbers to the nearest 10 and also learning Roman numerals.

We continue to write the opening to our own version of the Iron Man, focusing on writing engaging sentences for our reader. This week, we used brackets, personification, and dialogue in our writing.

In history, children learnt that the Heptarchy was the division of Anglo-Saxon England and they were introduced to the names of all seven kingdoms.

In computing, children considered what the key features of certain types of websites are and why some might be more important than others.

In art this week, children used several painting techniques and tools to appreciate that effects can be created in multiple ways, using paint. They used stippling and dabbing with their brushes and cotton buds to create a pointillism effect.

In PSHE, children reflected on healthy friendships and recognised that we each have personal boundaries which should be respected.
