In maths this week, we have started our unit on addition and subtraction. The children have been adding two 4-digit numbers with no exchange, one exchange and more than one exchange.

In English, the children are becoming more confident in their writing, adding their unique flair to their sentence choices. This week, we revisited similes and introduced relative clauses.

It was time for another experiment in science this week. Our focus was on evaporation and the children conducted an experiment to understand how temperature affects the rate of evaporation.

In PSHE this week, we discussed and reflected on how our own behaviour impacts those around us. We talked about acts of kindness and how they can make both the recipient and ourselves feel.

In computing, we considered whether we can believe everything we read online. We role modelled how quickly and easily messages online are shared and how once they are sent, they can travel far and wide and that we cannot always be sure these messages are genuine.

In RE this term, children have been learning about God's promises to his people. This week, children drew a piece of art reflecting Jesus as the fulfilment of God's promises.
