It was lovely to see all the children back after our half term break.

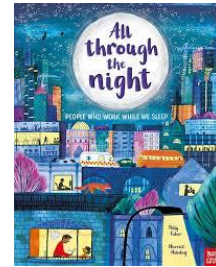
