

Our Learning Journey

Our learning this week has involved a lot of science. Children have continued to plant all the flowers and bulbs in our patio area as the weather has improved. They have also been working scientifically by observing the bulbs over the last week and we have prepared a little experiment with two bulbs in our classroom. One bulb will receive all the love, care, food, water, air and light that it needs in order to grow but the other poor one will receive nothing!

Children have sequenced pictures of how they planted the bulbs then they wrote a recount. Finally, they have written up their experiment sheet detailing the equipment used, their prediction and the method.



In maths, we are skip counting in 2s and 5s. Children are singing the times table, grouping into 2s and 5s, sorting numicon pieces and writing short sentences. They have been using a Hundred Square to help and have skip counted on a number line.

Focus on Learning

Our phonics next week will focus on split digraphs again: a_e; e_e; i_e; o_e and u_e. Words like:

Cake / Theme / Kite / Rope / Cube

In science, we will be labelling the human body and we will be performing some activities using our senses.

In maths, we will be counting in 10s and then we will try and solve some word problems involving the 2, 5 and 10 times tables.

Our history will also commence next week and we will be looking at some key events from the 1960's. Children will watch video footage of the Queen, the Beatles and the moon landing.
