We've embraced the start of Advent with an
'Acts of Kindness' calendar and a lucky-dip
Christmas book each day.

This week we learnt how to multiply three
numbers. We played games to help consolidate
our learning and means we've now finished our
first unit on multiplication and division.
Children completed their end of unit quiz
which covered all the areas of learning from
the last few weeks.

In English, children have finished writing
their 1st person recount of Odd's adventure.
They have focused on using subordinating
conjunctions and pronouns to give them work
more cohesion.

In history, children learnt more about Alfred
the Great and reflected on whether he is
worthy of his name.

In computing, children finished recording
their podcasts and added sound effects and
music. They started to edit their work,
thinking about whether to layer their sounds
or align them with their voices.

In science, we played with various
instruments as part of our further
exploration of pitch.
