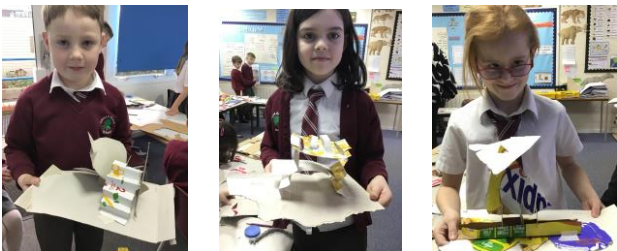


YEAR 3 WEEKLY LEARNING

Autumn Term

Art

During this lesson, the children investigated how flat, 2D card shapes could be transformed into 3D structures. They experimented with folding and rolling the cardboard to give it strength and stability and explored using the slot technique to join pieces together securely without the need for glue or tape. Some children found it helpful to draw around 2D shape templates before cutting, while others chose to design and cut their own shapes. Children were also encouraged to think creatively about alternative ways to combine and support shapes, such as balancing them carefully or folding pieces over each other to interlock. The focus was on developing and refining joining and construction skills rather than producing a specific finished product, with the key aim being to create a self-supporting 3D model.
