Nursery Activities and Play

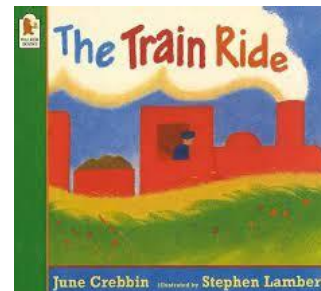
