This week, we finished reading FaRther and we're now writing a sequel to the story. We are using the original story to inspire us and implementing our learning from across the unit into our work.

In maths, we have been spending time learning how to divide a 2-digit number by a 1-digit number using a place value chart and counters. Children have also explored using part whole models to support them when place value charts aren't available.

Dodgeball is always something everyone enjoys and this week children focused on their throwing and catching skills as they worked in teams to get their opposing team out.

Forest school continues to be a highlight of the week and yesterday, children were treated to marshmallows round the campfire!

We have continued to explore circuits in science. Children used different components within their circuits, such as motors, lights and buzzers.

In computing, children learnt how to programme shapes using count-controlled loops in their code.

Proportion was our focus in art this week. Children considered a selection of artworks and used question prompts and word banks to explain to their partners how the artist had used proportion in their work.
