This week in maths, we have been exploring perimeter. We have focused on rectilinear shapes and recognised how to problem solve when working out the perimeter of shapes with missing measurements.

We have started reading The Matchbox Diary this term - a story of how a man kept mementoes from his childhood to act as a diary, when he couldn't write. This week, we made comparative statements using antonyms and written speech featuring different sentence types.

In PSHE this week, we explored the positive and negative side of sharing on the internet. We discussed what we need to consider before sharing and looked at how quickly things are shared online as opposed to offline.

In Geography, we revisited continents to help support our understanding of where Florida is. We then learnt about the different time zones around the world - discussing the lines of longitude - and why some places in the world experience day, when others experience night.

Computing this term looks at how data is logged and how this information can then be used. This week, we looked at how data over time, can be used to answer questions.

We were lucky with the weather on Wednesday and were able to use the paddock area outside Year 2 for our yoga class. We practiced the 'I am...' flow with positive affirmations.
