

# YEAR 3 WEEKLY LEARNING

## Autumn Term

### Maths

This week, the children began their new Maths topic on Fractions. They started by reinforcing their learning from KS1, recalling that a fraction represents a part of a whole and that to find a unit fraction, the whole must be divided into equal parts. The children revisited the role of the denominator, understanding that it shows how many equal parts the whole has been divided into. Building on this knowledge, they then used their understanding of denominators to compare and order unit fractions, recognising that the larger the denominator, the smaller the unit fraction.

### Delight in Dance

This week, the children really enjoyed learning the Heroes versus Villains dance and were excited to bring their characters to life through movement. They continued to rehearse with great enthusiasm, working hard to remember the choreography and perform with expression. While running through the piece so far, the children carefully practiced the transitions and made sure they knew when they need to come in and out. This will help the performance flow smoothly and build the children's confidence. It is also essential to ensure the children feel secure and confident with their movements so they can perform proudly and enjoy the experience.
