Here we are exploring the sense of touch

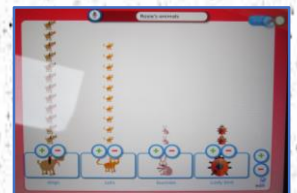


We had some wonderful sentences by the end of the lesson:
