

YEAR 3 WEEKLY LEARNING

Autumn Term

English

In English lessons, the children continued reading the BFG. This week they focused on improving their dialogue by using a range of synonyms for the word "said." The children then explored Sophie's character in more depth, thinking about not only what she is like on the outside but also how she feels throughout the story. They discussed her emotions during different events in the book and how these experiences might affect her thoughts and feelings. To develop their understanding, the children wrote a diary entry from Sophie's perspective, reflecting on the events that have happened so far and expressing her emotions about meeting the BFG and entering the mysterious world of giants.

RE

In their RE lesson, the children explored how Jesus showed he was God's Son by performing miracles. They discussed the meaning of awe and wonder and thought about how people can feel amazed by both miracles and God's creations. The class listened to and explored different miracle stories from the Bible and talked about what these miracles showed about Jesus. Following this, the children chose one miracle story and worked together to create a freeze frame to represent it. They then explained what was happening in their scene and why the miracle was important.
