Something very strange happened this week in Year 1. It looked like something had crashed into our outdoor area! The scene was taped off, but there were a few clues left behind, like yellow fluff and footprints. In Maths, we have continued exploring numbers up to 50, with a focus on the number line. The children have been practising counting forwards and backwards from any given number, ordering numbers, and using terms like '1 more' and '1 less'.
