Welcome back to the Summer term. I hope everyone enjoyed a peaceful Easter break. Despite learning the sad news about Miss Watts, the children have been in good spirits this week. Please do get in touch if you have any worries about how the news may have affected your child.

We were lucky this week to take part in a judo taster session which the children really enjoyed. Children also watched an assembly to see more judo skills in action.

Our learning has moved onto decimals in maths. We have recapped tenths as fractions and how these look as decimals. We have learnt what tenths look like on a place value chart and a number line - recognising that ten tenths can be exchanged for one whole.

It is now athletics season and children enjoyed their first lesson with Mrs Masey this week. District Sports trials will be held in PE lessons across the next few weeks.

We have started to read our new book Cinnamon in English. Children made predictions about the book and wrote an advert in role as Cinnamon's parents, using abstract nouns to express their feelings.

Animals including humans is our science topic this term and we are exploring teeth and the digestive system. This week, children learnt the names and functions of human teeth.

In DT, children evaluated the use and purpose of aprons and created their design for their own apron. In computing, children used a photo editing programme to crop images.
