This week we have had a real focus on revising grammar but I hope the children will agree that it hasn't been deathly boring. On Tuesday, for example, they made their own pairs game with root words and prefixes and on Wednesday we spent time outside doing different activities in order to create sentences in different tenses.

Maths

Again, revision and repetition have been key to this week's lessons with extra work on times tables and mental maths calculations. The main focus in lessons however has been on fractions - adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing them - and I believe the class have loved the chance to write out columns of questions and just answer them using a learnt method in the way we used to in 'The Olden Days!' In addition to this, as a bit of light relief (and linked to revising the terms radius, diameter and circumference), I taught them how to use a pair of compasses. When I drew the first 'perfect' circle their faces were a picture and I think some might have thought real magic was at work!
