What an incredible start to the week we had here at Ongar as we enjoyed the Mini marathon event! The sun was shining, the children were full of energy and it really was a hugely enjoyable afternoon. The children have been working hard and doing very well in their maths this week - learning how to represent tenths and hundredths in decimals. We have explored what is happening on the place value chart and used flexible partitioning to partition a number into tenths and hundredths.

Poetry has been at the fore of our English learning this week. Children wrote a poem using similes and then tried their hand at a limerick! They learnt about the rhyme and rhythm of a limerick and did so well creating their own!

In computing, children continued to edit photos. This week, they looked at how different effects can affect how we feel when looking at pictures.

In science, we planned and set-up our experiment to explore which drink causes most tooth decay. We are using the shell of eggs to replicate enamel and have left the eggs in different liquids which we will observe for change over the next week.
